PAYMENT METHODS

Payment can now be made at the office. Our preferred method of payment is Eftpos. If you are unable to attend the office, payment can be made by providing your credit card details to Tania or Anna in the office by phoning 5721.3491.

PLEASE NOTE: Charges reflect the actual costs to the school. Whilst sections shown as "voluntary charges" are just that, the decision not to contribute has a significant impact on the school's ability to provide the programs and computer access that enrich your child's learning. School Council always endeavours to keep charges to a minimum.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Student Stationery

The school will order year level stationery packs for your child. Packs have been competitively quoted and represent good value. Once payment has been made, stationery packs will be given to your child's teacher for distribution first day of school. The materials should be sufficient for the year. Photocopy paper is used for copying of student worksheets and making of books etc, as part of literacy and other programs. If stationery packs are not purchased through the school, parents are expected to supply stationery themselves. (Pack lists with brand and quantities required are available from the office on request). The advantages of purchasing stationery packs are that costs reflect significant discounts and all children have consistent materials.

Materials Charge

This charge is for bulk classroom materials used by all children in all grades. These are consumable items that will be distributed by the class teacher as required over the course of the year.

Satchel

The satchel is water proof and for library books, take home readers, notices and grade newsletters. The satchels are made of synthetic material. This one off purchase should last your child for his/her primary schooling.

Digital Technology

We use this money to provide high quality computer facilities and access for your child. At Wangaratta West Primary School, students use computers and other digital tools throughout the day, and they are integral to our learning program. Please contribute to this so that we can upgrade our resources regularly and provide your child with access to these tools.

Buildings and Grounds

Contributions to this help us to maintain the buildings and playground equipment.

Extra Charges (throughout the year)

There will be extra charges during the year for **swimming (approx. \$50 for five sessions)** and excursions/incursions, which will be charged as they come up during the year with notification to you as soon as practicable for payment.
